Cape Seal is a widely used Pavement Maintenance tool which incorporates a flexible membrane interlayer (SAMI or FiberMat® Type B) covered with either a Slurry Seal or Micro Surfacing. Cape Seal is one of the most economical treatments for addressing fair to moderately cracked pavements, while providing a smooth, dense surface, one having good skid resistance and long service life.

- Smooth texture with no loose aggregate
- Addresses distresses and provides smooth final riding surface
